






### Access to the User's meeting

The easiest way coming from Paris is to stop at the Massy-Palaiseau RER B station and take the 91.06(B,C) or 91.10 bus and stop at the « Lozère » bus stop (1) on the campus. From there, follow the path (in red) to enter the main building at the accueil / reception service (2) (where you will a priori need to identify yourself), then you can access the Becquerel amphitheatre (3) where the user meeting is held.



#### You can also:

- Stop at the « Lozère » RER B station (4) and use the pedestrian route (approx. 15-minute walk, 300 steps. In orange) up to the campus.
- Access by car (in blue): enter to the campus by the main entrance (5) and park on the parking for visitors (6). Then walk to the reception service (2).
